A Service to the Community	Students identify, develop and complete a service learning project in the local community. Let's Talk Difference	Students from diverse cultural backgrounds engage in a Socratic circle dialogue to discuss and share ideas relating to cultural and interfaith beliefs.	Students: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● work in teams, demonstrating understanding, tolerance, inclusion and integrity</li> <li>● show respect and empathy through interactions with people from different cultural backgrounds</li> <li>● demonstrate resilience and optimism through dialogue and exchange.</li> </ul>
Meeting the Technology Challenge	Students work in teams to research, design and construct a technological device for entry into a competitive challenge.	Students: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● work inclusively in teams</li> <li>● demonstrate understanding, tolerance, compassion and responsibility in a work project</li> <li>● enact the link between personal values and behaviour.</li> </ul>
Rock Through Values	Personal and group values are explored and enacted through a performance challenge (Rock Eisteddfod).	Students: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● do their best and commit to working collaboratively on a creative activity</li> <li>● show respect and tolerance for others who have different skill sets and abilities</li> <li>● develop skills of resilience and wellbeing through working toward a shared outcome.</li> </ul>
Head, Heart and Hands	An action-learning based project to explore concepts of social justice in the local community.	Students: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● enact understanding and empathy for a range of people regardless of circumstance</li> <li>● show responsibility for planning and implementing a project</li> <li>● enact the link between social justice, personal values and behaviour.</li> </ul>
Virtual Safety	A collaborative student-led project to develop a Code of Online Safety Conduct for the school.	Students: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● work in teams, demonstrating responsibility, tolerance and cooperation</li> <li>● seek an outcome that embodies respect for others, trustworthiness, inclusion and a fair go for all</li> <li>● enact the link between personal values and behaviour both online and in other contexts.</li> </ul>
